

**Dr. Go Tanaka** is the Councilor of the Coordination Office of Measures on Emerging Infectious Diseases, Cabinet Secretariat, Government of Japan. He is also designated for Visiting Associate Professor at Graduate School of Medicine, Osaka University and at School of Public Health, Teikyo University in Japan.

He obtained a Medical Degree in 1998 at School of Medicine, Osaka University, as well as a Master of Public Health in 2005 at School of Public Health, Emory University in the US, and a PhD Diploma in 2007 at Graduate School of Medicine, Juntendo University. He completed clinical fellowship training in pediatrics at Okinawa Chubu Hospital, from 1998 to 2000, and in ER at Osaka Police Hospital, from 2000 to 2001. He also had a chance to work as Visiting Clinical Trainer at Peshawar Medical Center in Pakistan and Afghanistan in 2001.

He joined the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare, Japan in 2001 and has experienced a various field of public health career such as HIV/AIDS, Food Safety, Mental Health, and Perinatal & Emergency Medicine. He was appointed as Visiting Researcher of Infectious Diseases & Vaccine Sciences Department at International Centre for Diarrhoeal Disease Research, Bangladesh in 2005, as well as Director of Public Health & Medical Treatment Division at Gifu Prefecture from 2006 to 2009, and Director of Medical Research and Business Development at National Center of Neurology and Psychiatry, Tokyo from 2009 to 2011.

Previously He joined the WHO's Western Pacific Regional Office in Manila as Partnership in Technical Cooperation till 2015.
